



Carol L. Kenzer Memorial Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

The Carol L. Kenzer Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship established in memory of Carol L. Kenzer, who taught social studies for 24 years in North Carolina, Utah, and Virginia, including the last 10 years of her life at Moody Middle School in Henrico County.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicant must:

- Have attended and completed the International Baccalaureate program at Moody Middle School
- Presently be attending college or be a high school senior planning to attend a four-year college or university

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Application should be completed with care and attention to detail.
- Your two essays represent you. They should be typed, double-spaced, and free of grammatical errors.
- A current high school transcript must accompany the application. Applicants already attending college need only submit their updated college transcript.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university the student is attending and may be used for tuition, books, or other school-related costs.

Students presently in college should focus on their two most significant college experiences. **Whether you are a high school senior or presently in college, one of these experiences must be of an academic nature, such as a class you took, a topic you learned about in a class, or an assignment such as a book you read or a paper you wrote.** (Print essays on separate pages and attach to application form.)
